· E-Safety means electronic safety.

If people online are mean or worry me:

What should I do?

- Tell an adult I trust straight away.
- Try to stay calm.
- Report anything that worries you.
- Try to ignore the person.
- Block and delete the person.
- Keep all messages for evidence.





What should I not do? - Do not keep worries to yourself.

- Do not be unkind or nasty back.
- Do not get angry or upset.
- Do not delete messages.

Who can we tell if we have worries about e-safety or Cyber-bullying?

- An adult in school, maybe Mrs Sear, Mrs Hill, Mrs Clarke or Mrs Gallagher?
- Your teacher or the adult in your class
- Tell your parent or the person you live with
- Put it on paper and into your class Worry Monster
